Oberdan Bezzi, designers who have got to know very well on the blog, has recently proposed the Victory Sports Roadster, powered by twin naked Freedom and belt drive, closest to the concept that inspired the Yamaha MT-01 and to marry perfection of the new atypical naked Victory.

Creation of "material" instead of this idea was proposed by Allmond Cycle Design, the British studio that produced, starting from the twin Victory, a naked very special called "V-Sports." Although the bike is devoid of details to be driven and equipped with technical solutions disinclined to enhance the driving pleasure, the V-Sport gives an idea of the new, hypothetical, Victory over again.
